## **Your Idaho Team**



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Idaho's Reading Indicator (IRI) is administered to all K-3 public school students. IRI is an early reading screener and diagnostic assessment. The screener is mandatory for Idaho public school students in the Fall and Spring with optional winter administration. Progress monitoring is available to all students.



# **Purpose of IRI - Provided by Istation**



- Screen to identify students who are at-risk for struggling with core instruction
- Plan whole group and small group instruction
- Determine **IF and Degree of Intensity** of interventions needed
- Progress Monitor to Track Growth



## **Best Practices:**



#### **Model The Assessment**

- Model listening the each question carefully as some questions will not be repeated
  - Listening Comprehension
  - Alphabetic Decoding

#### Model how to repeat instructions & answer choices:

- Phonemic Awareness hover or select the speaker icon
- Vocabulary hover, select the speaker icon (lower band) or select the question mark (upper band)

#### **Technology Check**

- If using a tablet or laptop, check battery power or ensure the device is plugged into a power source prior to testing
- Ensure headphones operate properly and check them periodically
- Check volume level have students confirm level of sound prior to working in Istation

#### **Actively Monitor**

- Observe students but please do not aid in answering questions as this will affect their data and instructional placement
- Encourage your kids to do their best to ensure the most accurate data
- Schedule 20-40 minutes to complete the assessment

#### **Guided Practice**

#### CAT

The assessment will begin by providing students with explicit directions and modeled expectations for each subtest Students will move into a guided practice question where the narrator guides students to the correct response before moving on. Students will begin their assessment with a grade level question. The rigor of each subsequent question will then adapt based on the child's response.
