MEMORANDUM

TO: District Superintendents, Charter School Administrators, K–3 Plus Coordinators, and STARS Coordinators

RE: Istation K-3 Reading Assessment 2017-2018

In the 2017-2018 school year, Istation will continue to be used for grades K–2 to measure growth within the foundational skills of Literacy. This assessment is funded by the Public Education Department.

It is the responsibility of the district or charter school to provide supports to their schools and ensure that teachers participate in training to ensure full implementation of Istation. STARS Coordinator(s) and/or Technology Coordinator (s) will have essential roles in supporting the process of uploading student and teacher information.

Please note that teachers will only be able to access the online training when student and teacher information has been uploaded to the Istation system.

Per 6.69.8.8 NMAC, each district and charter is required to use valid and reliable measures of student achievement growth approved by the Public Education Department. Istation will serve as the state's only approved statewide assessment for grades K–2 for purposes of NMTEACH.

Student Rostering and Imports

The STARS Coordinator or any district personnel with a manager account in Istation will have an essential role in supporting the process of uploading student and teacher information.

For those districts that participated in K-3 Plus, it is recommended that they wait until the end of the K-3 Plus program to roster students if students in K-3 Plus will be attending a different campus during the regular school year. This will move the student to the new campus updating their login username and interfering with the conclusion of the K-3 Plus program. Non-K3 Plus districts should verify that roster imports are configured for the 2017/2018 school year and rostering can begin anytime.

In the event that a primary District Contact needs to be added or changed, Istation Support can assist with this process. A current District Level Contact or Manager will need to complete the following:

1. Send an email request to support@istation.com specifying that you would like to have a new district user added in.
2. Provide the new user's full name, email address, and role to ensure the account is properly created.
3. Once the account has been created, Istation Support will notify both the requester and the new account owner.

When uploading student and teacher information, please ensure that correct district, school, teacher, and student IDs are included.
