



Installation for Windows

Services and Support

Use the following instructions to install Istation on computers that meet the Windows system requirements (to view the system requirements, visit <http://www.istation.com/Support#platform>).

If there is a security or write protection program on the computer, follow the protection program's instructions for disabling the program before installing. Istation requires a persistent folder on the hard disk that allows students to read, write, and execute. Programs that inhibit this operation, such as Deep Freeze or Clean Slate, must be configured to permit Istation to save data to its folder.

*Istation also offers an [MSI package](#) for remote deployment.

NOTE: You must be logged in with administrator credentials when installing Istation.

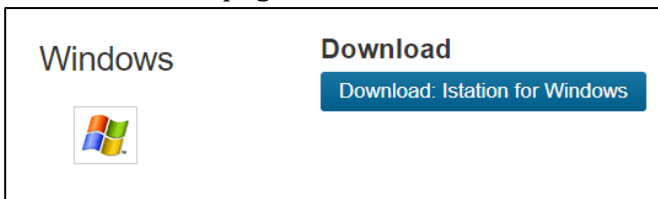

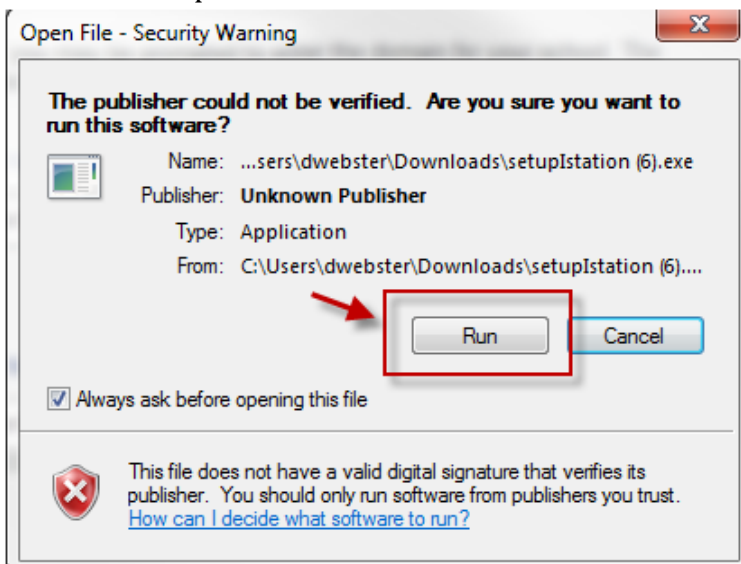
1. **Before downloading the Istation application**, please make sure your system meets or exceeds the minimum hardware requirements by reviewing the **technical specifications** below for your platform.
2. Click on the appropriate **download** option for your platform.

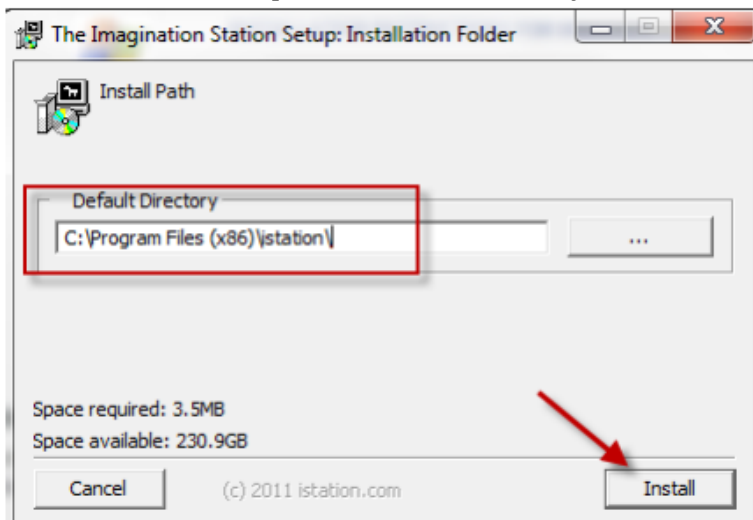
2. Scroll down the page and click the blue **Download: Istation for Windows** button.



3. Click **Run** to open.

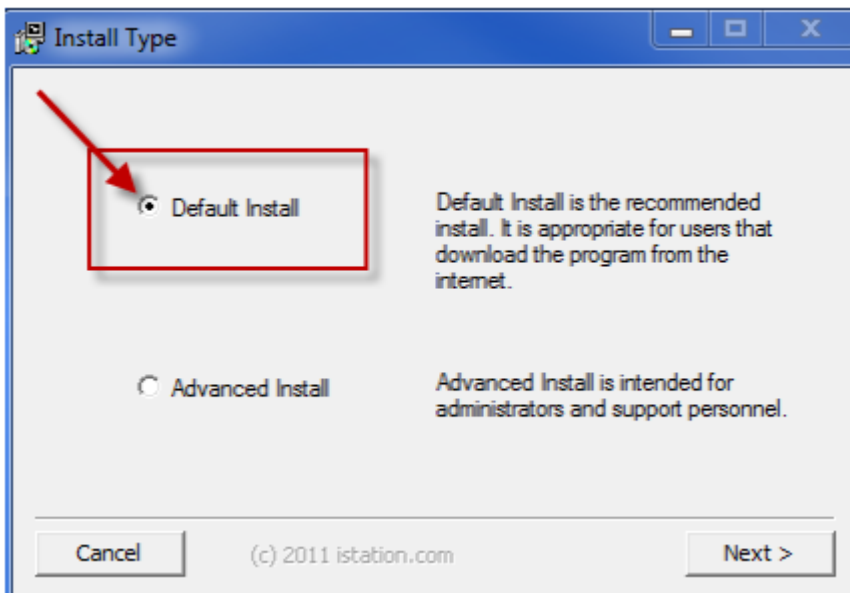


4. Click **Install** to accept the default directory.



5. Click **Next** to accept the default installation.

6. The program should run automatically. If not, minimize the website and click **on The Imagination Station** icon to start.



7. Type your school domain in the **Default Domain** box, if it is not automatically supplied. If you do not know your domain, you may search for it by typing the name of your school.
NOTE: Do not type in the **Peer Group** area.

8. Click **OK**. The application will automatically restart.
